1. Call to Order- David McWilliams called the meeting to order at 4:01 p.m. at the Bellows Free Academy Library.

2. New Business

a. Building Design- David Roy from Wiemann Lamphere presented a proposed building design for NWATV's new building. The building will be a 3200 square foot building. Wiemann & Lamphere will hire the structural, mechanical, civil, and electrical engineers. Mr. Roy gave all cost estimates and would like the building to go out to bid in the Fall/Winter of 2016, to begin building in 2017. The studio will be a contemporary barn structure and will have attic space for added storage. The projected construction cost is \$842,000 and with fixtures, furniture, equipment, and permits the total cost should be around \$1,136,120.00.

b. Ann Levy- Mrs. Levy expressed her concern for NWATV to purchase a building as she was afraid that if NWATV goes out of business, the building will need to be sold. Mrs. Levy is a former Comcast customer who has switched providers, and believes that many more people will switch from Comcast in the coming years. Rick Tatro explained that NWATV had searched in the past for a building and none of the buildings would suit NWATV's needs.

3. Programming Report- Paul Snyder's report focused on MVU Football, and following the team over 4 mini shows. The first show was named "Roll Like Thunder" which introduced the coach, Coach Bushey to the community, and a glimpse of the conditioning the football players were doing at the voluntary practice which is before the preseason. Paul Snyder would like to get MVU football to get more community involvement and support from the community.

4. Treasurer's Report- The Treasurer's Report was attached to the Board's packets.

Tim Stetson made the motion to accept the Treasurer's report as presented; Joe Halko seconded the motion. The motion carried 9-0-0.

Michel Consejo made the motion to accept the checks written in the months of May

## and June of 2016; Gregg Gervais seconded the motion. The motion carried 9-0-0.

5. Executive Director's Report- Elizabeth Malone was happy to announce that the air conditioning was finally working again. It has not been working properly for a while. The control room was reaching temperatures over 80 degrees, so shows needed to be rescheduled or the times of the shows needed to be cut. The Primary Day voting was a great practice run for Election Day. The St. Albans Messenger had 3 reporters that worked with NWATV to produce the show. Elizabeth Malone explained NWATV left Paydata (the payroll company) and went to MGV Associates, this was a good switch with less costs to produce paychecks and the questions around the issues with security of information is not being questioned with the new company. The Comcast payment was received which was \$88,000. Elizabeth Malone does not have any information about the North Country, the cables are in, just not connected. The live lines from Cold Hollow are in the computer lab which Comcast installed over the summer. The October meeting is the Annual Meeting which will be combined as the Annual Meeting and Monthly Meeting, and will be held at BFA. The Northwest Nightmares will be hosted again this year at the Welden Theater.

a. Camera Quotes- Elizabeth Malone explained they would like to get 2 new cameras for the St. Albans location, and will then give North Country (once it's up and running) the older cameras as there are not enough cameras currently for both locations. The Board was given quotes by B&H Photo-\$4689, Access AV-\$4457, and PowerShot-\$4490. Elizabeth Malone recommended to go with Access AV, they are a more local company and their price is the lowest.

Tim Stetson made the motion to purchase two cameras, and tripods from Access AV; Marilyn Grunewald seconded the motion. The motion carried 9-0-0.

b. Committee Sign Up- A sign-up sheet was passed to the Board Members to sign up for committee work.
